"Move Over, Bingo, There's a New Game in Town!"

Move over, Bingo, there's a new game in town! Cane-Fu, a new self-defense art form for senior citizens, has seen its popularity enhanced by the YouTube video, "Granny C. Takes on the Bullet Man." It depicts an agile woman in her seventies jabbing and taking down a man in a helmet pretending to be an intruder. Mark Shuey, a martial arts expert who founded Cane Masters, an Incline Village, Nevada, school for senior cane fighting, has also done much to propel Cane-Fu fighting to its current "star" status. He started studying cane moves about a decade ago while practicing his own personal form of self defense (hapkido), which incorporates stick fighting at advanced levels. The beauty of Cane-Fu fighting is the idea that something one already owns and is likely to have on hand can be used as an effective weapon. Senior centers and retirement communities see this as a new way to promote healthful exercise as well. According to Lena Mast, manager of an independent living complex for seniors in Salisbury, Maryland, who began offering cane classes earlier this year: "It's a huge hit. And now it's the top thing our seniors look forward to." Although many seniors take Cane-Fu classes, it is rare that they ever use the skills they have honed. Last year, Bill Carter from Jacksonville, Florida, however, found his instruction came in handy when he returned to his home one spring day only to find an intruder in his kitchen who was stealing TV dinners from his freezer. Bill said: "As the man approached, I popped him on the kneecap and hooked him behind the neck. I was then able to guide him to the door."

Is Cane-Fu Kosher? The Rambam (Maimonides) writes: "It is a positive commandment to remove, guard against, and warn against any life-threatening obstacle, as it says: 'Take utmost care and guard yourself scrupulously' (Deuteronomy 4:9)." So perhaps seniors can invoke Teddy Roosevelt's old adage to "walk softly but carry a big stick."

Parshas Shelach Numbers 13:1 - 15:41

Moses is pressed by the Jewish people to send twelve spies to the Land of Canaan (later to be called the Land of Israel). Forty days later they return carrying a gigantic cluster of grapes and two other large fruits. Ten of the spies warn that the inhabitants of the land are enormous in size and that the land 'consumes its inhabitants'. They convince the people that the land can't be conquered. Caleb and Joshua retain their faith in G-d, insisting that the Jewish people can, indeed, conquer the land. The people weep and proclaim that they'd rather return to Egypt. This tenth expression of a profound lack of faith in G-d prompts a Divine decree that entry into the Land should be delayed forty years. This decree was made on the ninth of the Hebrew month of Av-known as Tisha B'Av. Numerous other tragedies occurred on Tisha B'Av, including the destruction of the first and second Temples and the expulsion of Spanish Jewry in 1492. Parshas Shelach concludes with the command to place fringes (tzitzis) on the

corners of a four-cornered garment. Tzitzis help us to remember to fulfill all of the Divine commandments.

Rabbinic Ruminations

Bio-Bee Biological Systems Ltd. is a small company that provides natural forms of biological pest control, in a variety of novel ways, to farmers all over the world from its base in northern Israel. Founded in 1984 in Kibbutz Sde Eliyahu, BioBee's facility mass-produces eight different species of biological control agents, plus pollinating bumblebees, to 32 nations from Japan to Chile. About 45 percent of its market is domestic. Subsidiary BioFly produces sterile male Mediterranean fruit flies for release among crops. One of Bio-Bee's latest projects is to provide "predatory bugs" to help its farmers get rid of pests – the natural way. By employing predatory bugs that attack and kill harmful insects, BioBee has developed a technique free of chemicals.

Farmers in the South American country of Colombia recently received 600 million spider mites from Bio-Bee. Also dubbed "Bio Persimilis," each spider is double the size of the harmful mites it attacks, and moves around faster too which helps it find lunch: the daily menu for each mite consists of as many as 7 of its smaller victims, which it gobbles up with gruesome relish, sucking out their insides and leaving only the outer skin behind. Bottles of the mites, each containing several thousand of the little critters, are distributed to farmers who then scatter them over their farms, in their greenhouses and among their fruit orchards. Bio-Bee's Mighty Mites cost more than their own weight in gold, selling for several thousands dollars just for a few grams.

The Torah teaches that Man has an obligation to improve the world. To teach this to us, G-d purposely left the world imperfect, in a sense, so that Man would be forced to further perfect the world. For example, when a person plants wheat seeds, G-d could have created the world in a way that the seeds grow and develop into Double Chocolate Gooey Brownies. Yum! But why do wheat seed ends up as a kernel of wheat that has to be ground up and made into flour? Just as the natural world requires further constructive work, so too Man himself requires further constructive work. G-d wants us to be a partner in the creative process, and that ultimately we should focus on recreating ourselves into better people.
