<u>Kashrus Alert Issued by the cRc</u> – Insects in Barley, Recent Infestations - After an assortment of manufacturers were inspected, it was found that infestation generally occurs <u>after</u> the grain is packaged; infestation was found even in containers bearing a reliable kosher logo. However, based on information from the Star-K, <u>Quaker and Jackrabbit Brands</u> of barley are insect free and <u>do not require checking</u>. The Vaad recommends that during Nov & Dec 2012, you should inspect other brands of barley before using it. For all details, please see the notice in the lobby describing what to look for and methods of inspection.
