An overflow crowd of several hundred people listened raptly to Dr. Bernd Wollschlaeger as he recounted his incredible life story at Nusach Hari synagogue last night. Introduced by Rabbi Ze'ev Smason, Wollschlaeger is the son of a decorated Nazi tank commander who rejected his father's values, converted to Judaism, made alivah to Israel, married a Jewish girl, served in the IDF, and now lives in Florida with his wife and children practicing family medicine. He signed his book, "A German Life: Against All Odds Change Is Possible" at a dessert reception following his presentation. An inspirational evening, but Wollschlaeger is "one of a kind;" his suggestion that we always continue to reach out to people whose beliefs are different than ours will not work - as he admitted - with groups like ISIS. Kudos to NHBZ for presenting the program so beautifully.
