## Sisterhood's NEW Book Club is Up and Running!

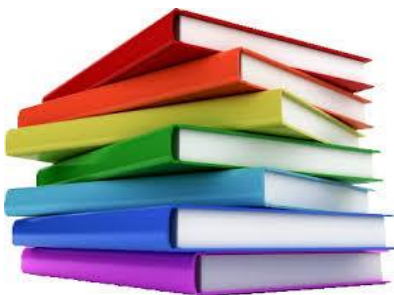
