Instructions to attend a class:

***For Zoom video:** each class has a Zoom link- click on the link or copy and paste the link in your browser to join the class.

Each weekday morning at 8:00 am **No Class April 8-11 and April 15-16** (Sundays, at 9:00 am.). **Rabbi Smason will share a 10 minute D'var Torah** (Torah insight) relevant to the upcoming holiday of Pesach (Passover). **This will take place by telephone conference only.** Dial-in number: 314-325-8791

FOR KIDS ~ Monday - Friday at 2:00 pm ~Will meet Monday and Tuesday, April 6-7, and resume after the end of Pesach Take a 10-minute break from your online school and join Rabbi Smason as we explore short daily topical, relevant Torah snippets about Passover for ages 7 to 12 years old.
